Get Ready

- *School programs or policies
- *Your child's progress
- *Ways you can support your child at home
- *Things you can share with the teacher about your child

Ask Questions

- *Is my child working up to his/her ability?
- *What could my child improve in?
- *How does my child get along with peers?
- *What can we do at home to support learning in the classroom?

Goals

- *Participate with your child and teacher in setting goals.
- *Communicate with the teacher throughout the year about your child's progress.
- *Remember, you are the best resource your child has in making the grade.

When teachers and parents work together, it helps a child have a successful school year.

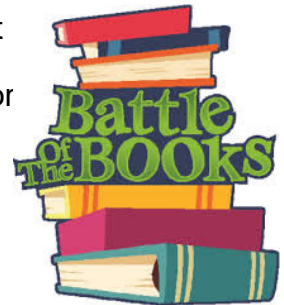
